 - 4. Adopt a resolution entitled Resolution Authorizing the July 1, 2024-June 30, 2029 Performance Based Curriculum Director Contract Between the Board of Education and Emily Lahti (7 ayes)
 - Adopt a resolution entitled Resolution Authorizing the July 1, 2024-June 30, 2029
 Performance Based Superintendent Contract Between the Board of Education
 and James Prather (7 ayes)
